

PHILOSOPHY STATEMENT

To carry out a bilingual educational program that provides a positive orientation of the student's behavior for children between the pre-school to middle school ages. Providing an integral process, that attains the development of a well rounded individual, in its social and personal dimensions. Providing attention to the physical and mental aspects, the intellectual development, the refinement of the appreciation of aesthetics art forms, the moral, civic and social formation. Considering that each child is an individual person, who has its own rhythm and learning style.

To provide adequate activities and experiences for the developmental needs and capacities of the students that will harmonize with his spontaneous life and that of the community.

To stimulate and ensure the development of basic physical, moral, and intellectual skills that allow for an adequate and satisfactory performance in latter education.

To develop a positive image of the self, the family, the peers, and the community. To cultivate and increase their natural interest for discovering and investigating the surrounding environment, thus developing a positive attitude towards learning.

To provide activities that will allow for the increase and maintenance of healthy, safe, and personal hygiene habits.

To encourage activities that will develop the student's interest in preserving and contributing solutions that aid in the conservation and responsible use of our natural resources.

To provide students with activities that encourage the acquisition of the traditional values of Puerto Rican culture, thus, reasserting their identity, by reclaiming the desire to preserve what has come, maintaining deeply rooted traditions, and receiving the noble commission of enhancing, creating and increasing what has been received, augmenting their cultural heritage.

These goals will be carried out in an orderly fashion and with the formality appropriate to the level of instruction given, understanding that at the pre-school level the instruction will be very flexible and less formal, but with the degree of organization proper to the level.
